

INFORMATION CLAUSE GDPR — KONFERENCJA HOOFSCARE

In accordance with Article 13(1) and (2) of the GDPR (EU), we hereby inform you that:

1. The controller of the personal data processed for the purposes of registration, ticket sales, and the organization of the Conference is Konik(nie)Bujany Natalia Szczęch, Łabędzie 100, 78-500 Drawsko Pomorskie, email: konferencja@hoofscare.pl.
2. If separate marketing consent is provided, the controller of personal data processed for marketing purposes is Hoofscare – Patryk Bas, email: konferencja@hoofscare.pl.
3. Personal data will be processed for the following purposes:
 - a. participant registration, ticket sales, and the organization of the Conference—pursuant to Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR;
 - b. fulfillment of accounting, tax, and financial reporting obligations—pursuant to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR;
 - c. investigations, determinations, or defense against claims—pursuant to Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR;
 - d. marketing of Hoofscare products and services — only if separate consent is provided, pursuant to Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.
4. The recipients of personal data may include entities supporting the organization of the Conference, in particular providers of payment, accounting, IT, postal, hosting, and mailing services, as well as other entities that process data under relevant agreements.
5. Personal data processed for the purpose of organizing the Conference will be retained for the period necessary to carry out the Conference, and thereafter for the period required by law, in particular tax and accounting regulations, as well as for the period during which any claims may be brought.
6. Personal data processed for marketing purposes by Hoofscare – Patryk Bas will be retained until you withdraw your consent or object to the processing of your data.
7. Photographs and video recordings may be taken during the Conference for the purpose of documenting and promoting the event. Participants' images may be processed based on the organizer's legitimate interest, i.e., documenting and promoting the event, in accordance with Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR. In the case of individual or posed photographs, the organizer may request separate consent.
8. The data subject has the right to:
 - a. access their data,
 - b. rectify their data,
 - c. erase their data,
 - d. restrict processing,
 - e. transfer their data,
 - f. object to the processing of their data,
 - g. withdraw their consent at any time if the processing is based on consent.

9. Withdrawing consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing carried out prior to its withdrawal. Withdrawing marketing consent does not affect your ability to participate in the Conference.

11. The data subject has the right to file a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office.
12. Providing the personal information required to purchase a ticket and attend the Conference is voluntary, but necessary for the conclusion and performance of the contract. Failure to provide this information will prevent you from purchasing a ticket and attending the Conference.
13. Personal data will not be transferred outside the European Economic Area or to international organizations, unless the IT tools used result in such a transfer. In that case, the transfer will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of the GDPR.
14. Personal data will not be processed by automated means, including profiling, that would produce legal effects or similarly significantly affect the data subject.
